- 3) The exhibit / project may include
 - a) A working model to explain a concept, principle or a process
 - b) An innovative design or technique
 - c) Application of basic principles of Science / Technology
 - d) Scheme / Design of a device or machine to reduce the production cost
 - e) Investigation - based study
- 4) The exhibits / projects will be evaluated by the experts as per the following criteria:
 - 20 % - students' own creativity and imagination
 - 15 % - Originality and innovativeness
 - 15 % - Scientific thought / Principle / Approach
 - 15 % - Technical skill / Workmanship
 - 15 % - Utility / Educational value
 - 10 % - Economic aspect, portability, durability
 - 10 % - Presentation-Explanation and Demonstration
- 5) No Registration Fee, No TA and DA.
- 6) Limited accommodation available for out station participants.
- 7) Tea and Lunch will be provided.
- 8) Three exhibits will be selected for each category and will be awarded as follows:
